A. Word on the Street	<p>Melanie: Peace at Home was awarded funds from UHA through the SHARE process. Two weeks ago, they acquired a vacant lot to build a 0-5 childcare or private preschool for all Peace at Home clients.</p> <p>Juliete: The Veggie Rx program is rolling out, 199 people enrolled thus far. Some have received debt cards, but all enrollees will receive them in the next two weeks. Also, with partners Thrive Umpqua is launching a Love Your Neighborhood campaign, starting with Eagle Landing, culminating with a community event called the longest table (dinner open for all) to take place on 8/24 on the Stewart Park Green Bridge (hopefully). Planning committee will start meeting shortly!</p> <p>DeeJay: Oregon Department of Education is looking for LGBTQ2SIA+ students, caregivers or service providers to join an advisory group</p> <p>Les: we held a resource fair in partnership with FEATT to discuss services for children with disabilities, open to all age groups. Also, holding the central Douglas County event tomorrow, 5/10. Planning to do one in the fall and one in the spring as well, touching on all parts of the county.</p> <p>Jerry: Adapt purchased two motels in Roseburg (partly through UHA SHARE funding) and plans to have all rooms up and running by late fall 2024. At one project, the rooms are held for adult men who are engaging in some level of addiction treatment. At another, they're helping folks find a path to self sufficiency, or medically fragile UHA members. This will help in the continuum of housing needs.
